KVK, Kancheepuram is working under the control of the Directorate of Extension Education, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University since 1985 in Kancheepuram District. This district comes under North Eastern Zone. The annual normal rainfall of the zone is 992.3mm. Paddy, Sugarcane, Groundnut, mango are the major crops.

**Mandatory activities**

Organized 180 training programmes covering 9681 participants of which 3311 are male and 6005 are female. Organised 20 FLDs in 127 ha with 485 farmers. 6 Technology assessments were carried out in 35 farmer's field. Demonstrations were taken up in cereals, Millets, Oil seeds, Pulses, Vegetables, fruit crops, Fodder, Dairy, Poultry, Fisheries and Value addition.
