KVK, Kancheepuram is working under the control of the Directorate of Extension Education, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University since 1985 in Kancheepuram District. This district comes under North Eastern Zone. The annual normal rainfall of the zone is 992.3mm. Paddy, Sugarcane, Groundnut, mango are the major crops.

Mandatory activities

Organized 134 training programmes covering 8068 participants of which 3317 are male and 4751 are female. Organised 13 FLDs in 205 ha with 121 farmers. 4 Technology assessments were carried out in 30 farmer's field. Demonstrations were taken up in cereals, Millets, Oil seeds, Pulses, Vegetables, fruit crops, Fodder, Dairy, Poultry, Fisheries and Value addition.
